

Reds' Milestones

Milestones Reached in 2011

Records noted below since 1972 unless noted otherwise.

The Reds earned their 700th win under Coaches Danley and Ervin.

The Reds moved to over .500 in spring games against Valley, the lone opponent that previously had a winning record against the Reds.

Upcoming Milestones in 2012

Spring

The Reds would earn their 150th home victory in the spring at the new Eaton Baseball Field (opened in spring 1997) with their first home win of the 2012 season, earning more than 10 home wins per season (current home record of 149-9 overall, 78-2 in league, and 21-0 in the postseason).

The Reds would earn their 30th consecutive State Tournament appearance by finishing the league season near the top of the standings.

The Reds would earn their 75th spring State Tournament win within a period of 20 years (prior to 2007, the State Champion each year went 4-0 at State, thus making it remarkable to average approx. 3.75 wins per year at State over 20 years) with their first win in the 2012 State Tournament.

The Reds would earn their 20th consecutive Regional Championship and Final Four appearance with two wins in the single-elimination Regional Tournament rounds.

The Reds would earn their 10th State Championship with 7 State Tournament wins.

Summer

The Reds would earn their 1,000th summer victory with their 15th win.

Future Potential Marks

100 spring State Tournament wins, projected in 2013 (90 State Tournament wins thus far from 1976-2011)
