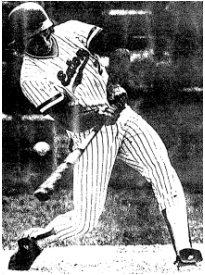

Ryan Fortune C #4	1990	All-State, hit .446 as sr., slugging .607, 322 career putouts, allowed less than 1 wild pitch/passed ball per game, batted 8-for-12 in '90 postseason prior to injury
Ray Garza P/3B/CF #4	1989	1 st Team All-State, 1.19 ERA as sr., 19-2 career record, hit .373 as sr., threw CG 1-hit shutout in '87 Districts, faced just 3 batters over the minimum in '89 Regionals
Randy Cordova P/3B/DH #3	1988	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-State, hit .536, slugged 1.196, 8 HR and 0 K's as sr., 259 career K's, won CG 8-inning 1-0 District semis, threw shutout in Regionals
Jim Reeman CF #2	1988	All-State, hit .413 as a senior with 10 stolen bases, after already scoring 5 times in game, hit game-winning single in '88 Districts, reaching base in all 7 at-bats
Bobby Ervin P/3B #2	1987	4-year starter, All-State, hit .424 with 20 RBI, scattered 5 hits in District Championship win, advanced Reds to State with save and win in '86 Districts
Mike Herzberg SS #1	1987	4-year starter, All-State, hit .397 as a senior, 10 steals in 10 attempts, scored game-winning run as only a sophomore in '85 Regional Championship
Ron Crowder P/C/RF #6	1986	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-State, hit .458 as only a sophomore, hit 2-out double and threw out 2 runners to secure '85 District semifinals and Reds' berth to State
Terry Specht CF #5	1986	All-State, hit .466 and slugged .983 as sr., scored game-winning run in '85 Regional semifinals, reached base in 11 of first 13 postseason at-bats in '85
Brad Grauberger CF/P #2	1985	1 st Team All-State, hit .400 as jr., and over .500 as sr. in limited at-bats due to injury, walked and scored in 2-1 Regional Title win, then singled to set up GW run
Pat McKay C/1B #4	1985	1 st Team All-Conference, hit .395 as jr., singled in '83 Regional Championship to move GW run into scoring position, RBI single and run secured '84 Regional semis
Scott Renfroe P/RF #3	1985	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-State, outpitched future MLB pitcher & singled in 2-out GW hit in 7 th inn. to win '85 Regionals, also won Regional games in '83 & '84
Paul Cordova P/SS/2B #1	1984	1 st Team All-Conference, hit .429 as a senior, posted 1.25 ERA as a junior, earned the win on the mound and scored 2 key runs in '83 State semifinal win
Mike Rosales P/2B/RF #1	1984	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-Conference, posted career ERA under 1.00, 0.84 ERA as sr., retired 9 of 1 st 10 batters and only allowed 2 runs in '84 Regional semis win
Mike Anderson P/SS/CF #3	1983	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-State, hit over .415 as so., jr., & sr., set then-record with 25 SB as so., knocked in tying run in '83 State semis, then earned the save
Mike McKay 1B #5	1983	All-State, hit .423 and slugged .596 as jr., led team with 28 runs as jr., singled and scored game's only run to win Regional Championship to send Reds to Final Four
Dudley Brown 3B #2	1982	1 st Team All-Conference, hit .407 as jr., drew 17 walks and knocked in 16 RBI, 2-run double added key insurance runs to secure the Regional semifinal win
Bill Kurtz C #4	1982	1 st Team All-Conference, hit .431 and slugged .638 as sr., tied then-record with 7 doubles as sr., 3-for-3 with HR and 2 RBI to lead Reds in '81 Regional semis
Bill Lawhead P/RF #3	1982	1 st Team All-Conference, 1.38 ERA as sr., hit .418 and slugged .642 as jr., had GW hit in '81 Regionals, threw CG 3-hit, 8 strikeout, 1-0 win in '82 District Title
Mark Anderson P/SS #4	1981	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-Conference, one of Reds' first .400 hitters, slugged .764 as jr., walked, stole 2 nd base, & scored winning run in Regional Championship
Steve Stencel P/SS #3	1981	1 st Team All-State, 26 wins & 301 K's in career, 0.85 ERA & 125 K's & hit .357 as sr., threw 15 K no-hitter in Regional semis, K'd 16 to earn Reds' 2 nd Regional Title

Approximately half of these Reds advanced to play baseball in college on scholarship.

All of the above players were selected to the East vs. West All-Star Game during the years it was played, and all were named All-Weld County once that selection began in 1987; the Reds were not as prominent throughout the entire state earlier in the decade and thus received fewer All-State selections during that period.

Note: '80 Graduate Dick Lawhead is listed on the 1970's Team as the bulk of his career was played in the 1970's.

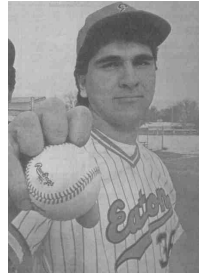

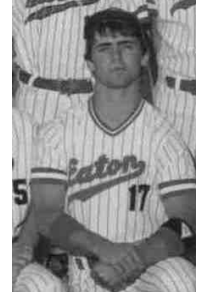

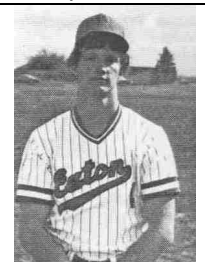

Joey Haythorn 1B	1988	2-year starter, hit .319, .559 on-base, singled, scored 7 th inn. GW run in districts
Dino Nolin DH/2B	1988	.702 on-base, hit .360, drew 7 th inn. walk tying wild 23-22 must-win district game
Eric Garretson CF/2B	1987	2-year starter, hit .355, slugged .484 as jr., hit in go-ahead run in '87 district title
Steve Graff C	1987	2-year starter, hit .328, .982 fielding pct., 0 postseason passed balls/wild pitches
Adam Kaiser DH	1987	Hit .377, hit in both runs in 2-0 '87 Regional win, GW 8 th inn. hit in 1-0 league win
Mike Templeman LF	1987	Hit .388 and slugged .769 with 6 home runs, hit 2-run 2-out HR to clinch districts
Shane Brown DH	1986	Hit .409, doubled in 8 th inn. and scored game-winning run in pivotal league game
Paul Friesen LF	1986	2-year starter, .337 lifetime BA, singled to score 1 st 2 runs in 4-3 '85 Regional win
Dan Gilbert DH	1985	Slugged .375, broke up no-hitter in 7 th inn. of Regionals to then score GW run
Doug Leafgren 3B	1984	2-year starter, hit .407, slugged .648, single and RBI in 1-0 '83 Regionals win
David Lawhead LF	1983	2-year starter, hit .341, 2 hits and 2 RBI led Reds to win in '83 district title game
Artie Grauberger OF	1982	Hit .354 with 2 home runs and 19 RBI, game-ending hit to wrap up league title
Joe Intermill 2B	1981	2-year starter, hit .342 with .478 on-base pct., 3 hits to lead Reds in Regional win
Stan Bauer 3B/LF	1980	2-year starter, hit .316 with 4 doubles, 8 th inn. GW 2-out hit to beat Valley in '79
Mike Galloway C/3B	1980	2-year starter, .541 on-base, 2 hits, 2 runs in District Semis led Reds to '79 State

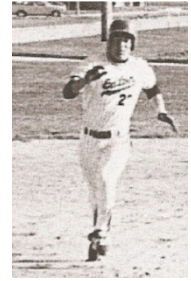

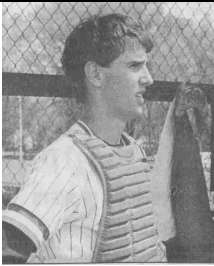
